Old Testament:

- 1. Discipline: lamadh, "to beat"
- 2. Law: yarah, "to cast"
- 3. Discernment: bin, "to separate"
- 4. Wisdom: sakhal, "to be wise"
- 5. Knowledge: yadha°, "to see" This verb literally means "to see" and consequently "to perceive," "to know," "to come to know
- 6. Illumination: zahar, "to shine"
- 7. Vision: ra°-ah, "to see"
- 8. Inspiration; nabha°, "to boil up"
- 9. Nourishment: ra±ah, "to feed a flock"

New Testament

- 1. Instruction: didasko, "to teach"
- 2. Acquisition: manthano, "to learn"
- 3. Presentation: paratithemi, "to place beside"
- 4. Elucidation: diermeneuo, "to interpret"
- 5. Exposition: ektithemi, "to place out"
- 6. Authority: prophetes, "one who speaks for"
- 7. Care: poimen, "a shepherd"
- 8. Supervision: episkopos, "an overseer"
